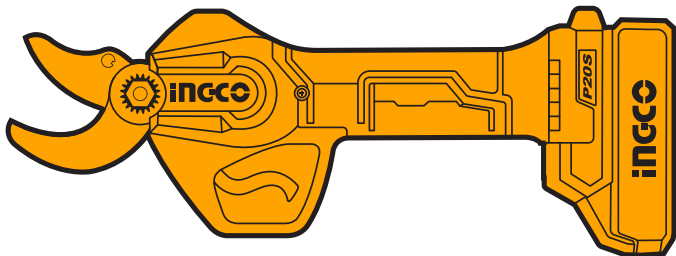

GENERAL POWER TOOL SAFETY WARNINGS

⚠ WARNING Read all safety warnings, instructions, illustrations and specifications provided with this power tool. *Failure to follow all instructions listed below may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.*

Save all warnings and instructions for future reference.

The term "power tool" in the warnings refers to your mains-operated (corded) power tool or battery-operated (cordless) power tool.

1) Work area safety

- a) **Keep work area clean and well lit.** *Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.*
- b) **Do not operate power tools in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases or dust.** *Power tools create sparks which may ignite the dust or fumes.*
- c) **Keep children and bystanders away while operating a power tool.** *Distractions can cause you to lose control.*

2) Electrical safety

- a) **Power tool plugs must match the outlet. Never modify the plug in any way.** **Do not use any adapter plugs with earthed (grounded) power tools.** *Unmodified plugs and matching outlets will reduce risk of electric shock.*
- b) **Avoid body contact with earthed or grounded surfaces, such as pipes, radiators, ranges and refrigerators.** *There is an increased risk of electric shock if your body is earthed or grounded.*

- b) **Never recharge a fully charged battery cartridge.** *Overcharging shortens the battery service life.*
- c) **Charge the battery cartridge with room temperature at 10°C-40°C (50°F-104°F).** *Let a hot battery cartridge cool down before charging it.*
- d) **Charge the battery cartridge if you do not use it for a long period (more than six months).**

Important safety instructions for battery cartridge

- 1. **Before using battery cartridge, read all instructions and cautionary markings on battery charger, battery, and) product using battery.**
- 2. **Do not disassemble battery cartridge.**
- 3. **If operating time has become excessively shorter, stop operating immediately.** *It may result in a risk of overheating, possible burns and even an explosion.*
- 4. **If electrolyte gets into your eyes, rinse them out with clear water and seek medical attention right away.** *It may result in loss of your eyesight.*

Tool / battery protection system

The tool is equipped with a tool/battery protection system. This system automatically cuts off power to the motor to extend tool and battery life. The tool will automatically stop during operation if the tool or battery is placed under one of the following conditions:

Overload protection

When the battery is operated in a manner that causes it to draw an abnormally high current, the tool automatically stops without any indication. In this situation, turn the tool off and stop the application that caused the tool to become overloaded. Then turn the tool on to restart.

Overheat protection

When the tool/battery is overheated, the tool stops automatically. In this situation, let the tool/battery cool before turning the tool on again.

Transportation

Batteries comply with all applicable shipping regulations as prescribed by industry and legal standards (for more information, check with the manufacturer).

Transporting batteries can possibly cause fire if the battery terminals inadvertently come in contact with conductive materials. When transporting batteries, make sure that the battery terminals are protected and well insulated from materials that could contact them and cause a short circuit.

3. Keep the pruning shears away from heat, oil, sharp edges or moving parts.

Human safety

1. Attention must be kept at a high level of alertness. Please read the instructions and the manual carefully before operating the electric pruning shears. Doing the operation and staying alert, do not perform related operations in the case of fatigue, drug or drinking. Distraction during work can cause serious personal injury;
2. When using safety protection devices, always wear protective equipment such as goggles. Under appropriate conditions, wear dustproof Masks, non-slip safety shoes, hard hats and hearing protection devices to reduce personal injury;
3. Always remove all adjustment keys or wrenches before the electric pruning shears are turned on, left in the electric pruning branches. The key or wrench on the rotating part can cause personal injury;
4. When operating, keep your hands away from the cutting area. Under any conditions, never bend your hand to the material. Next, make sure that any material under the shearing zone is not damaged by the cutting edge and that it needs to be kept at all times. Pay attention to the balance between the feet and the body in order to be able to control the electric pruning shears in the event of an accident;

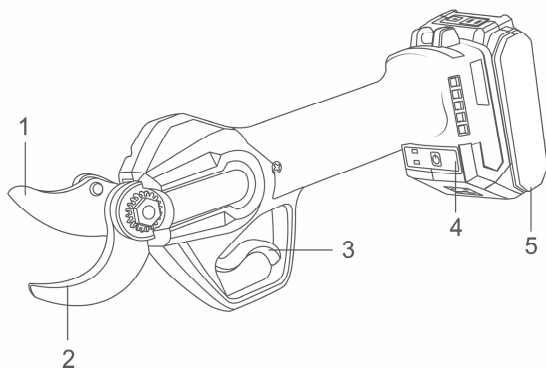

This equipment is designed for cutting branches and plants with a diameter of max. 25mm (softwood). The diameter is smaller for hardwood. This equipment is not suitable for cutting metal. The equipment is to be used only for its prescribed purpose.

Product operation

PRECAUTIONS

when using pruning shears, please ensure that fingers and other human body parts are not within the working scope of the blade. The operator shall be responsible for the damage caused by the operator's violation of the cautions.

Setting up

1. Insert the battery into the power connector of the pruner.
2. switch ON the power switch of the pruner. Due to the first-time usage that the LED display indicator will be green and the buzzer will buzz for 1 time.
3. Double click the trigger, the pruner blades will automatically open.
4. Normal pruning: press trigger to close the blades and release the trigger to open blades.
Blade closing: continue to press the trigger, a buzz means the blade will stay closed.
5. Before operation, in order to see if the pruner performances well, please press the trigger to close and release the trigger to open the blades without cutting anything. Repeat this for a few times.



Main switch (function description)

- Long press 2 seconds to turn on the machine
- Press once to switch gear
- Long press 2 seconds to turn off the machine



Two gear shifts the size of knife edge (cutting capacity) is different.

Trigger (function description)

- Quickly press the trigger twice to activate the action
- Suspend work for a long time, after dormancy, the machine also needs to press the trigger twice to activate the action.
- The knife edge will remain closed after long press of the trigger for 2 seconds, and the trigger will be reactivated by pressing the trigger for 2 times in a short time

Packing up

1. Press the trigger and hold for a few second and then release, the blade will close and will not open.

2. Switch off the battery, disconnect the battery.
3. Tidy up, clean up and pack the pruner into the tool box.

⚠ CAUTIONS

1. During charging, it is normal for the charger and battery to be warm.
2. If the battery is not used for a long period of time, it is recommended to charge the battery once every 3 months. This is to ensure the battery life is not affected by the low usage.
3. For new battery or battery unused for a long time, it will need about 5 charge-discharge cycles before achieving full capacity.
4. Do not recharge a fully charged battery just after a few minutes of usage, this will reduce the battery.
5. Do not use a damaged battery and do not disassemble the charger or battery.
6. Do not place battery near high temperature heat source, the battery high temperature heat source.
7. Do not charge the battery in outdoor or humid environment.
8. it is normal for the pruning shear to reduce cutting diameter when the battery capacity is getting low.
9. Do not use the pruning shear during charging. It must be disconnected from the battery during charging.
10. Do not store the battery in a humid environment.



Operation Precautions

Usage and Care for Pruning Shear

1. Do not cut branches beyond the specified diameter indicated, do not cut hard items such as metals, stone or any other non-plant materials. If the blades are worn or damaged, please replace the blades.
2. Keep the pruning shear clean, use a clean cloth to clean the pruning shear, battery and charger (do not use any abrasive or solvent-based cleaning agent), use a soft brush or a dry to clean the dust off the pruning shear head.
3. Do not immerse the pruning shear, battery or charger in any liquid.
4. Follow instructions as given for proper use of the pruning shear, do not use the pruning shear when the tool itself, battery or charger is damaged.

5. Do not use the pruning shear if it could not operate or shut down properly, send for servicing immediately. It is dangerous to use the pruning shear when the tool could not operate or shut down properly.
6. Please ensure the power pruner is powered OFF during any adjustment, changing.
7. accessories or storage. This protective measure aims to reduce the risk of accidental pruning shear activation.
8. Please ensure the blades are closed when not in use, storage of the pruning shear must keep out of reach from CHILDREN, do not allow any person who is not familiar with the pruner operation or instruction to use the pruning shear, it is dangerous to use the pruning shear without proper training and understanding.
9. The use of the pruning shear must comply with instructions stated in this manual and methods of use as well as taking in considerations of the working environment and nature of work undertaken. The use of the pruning shear not within its stated capability and specifications is dangerous.
10. Remove all dirt from the moving and fixed blades after each use, thereafter apply lubricant on the blade side where both moving and fixed blade contact. This will ensure the blades are maintained in good conditions and reduce resistance during use prolonging the pruner and blade lifespan.
11. Keep the battery out of reach from **CHILDREN**.
12. Do not use or place the battery under direct sunlight (or in vehicle that are under direct sunlight) that will cause the battery to overheat or burn shortening the battery lifespan.
13. Do not use the battery in electrostatic environment (above 64V).
14. Do not use battery that is corroded, with unpleasant odor or unusual appearance.
15. If the skin or clothing comes into direct contact with battery fluid, wash with clear water immediately.
16. Maintain the battery fully charged when the pruning shear is not used for a long period of time.

Irregularity measures

1. In the event the pruning shear is not able to cut through an object, released the trigger immediately and the moving blade will return to its open position

automatically.

2. In the event the pruning shear is cutting through a branch of particularly hardness, released the trigger immediately and the moving blade will return to its open position automatically.
3. In the event the battery is not charging properly, please check if the charger one provided with the package during purchase. Next is to ensure the supply voltage to the charger is same rating as the specification of the charger.
4. In the event of electric or mechanical malfunction, power OFF immediately.
5. Operating not following instructions in this manual may result battery fluid leakage, do not contact the leaked battery fluid. In the event of accidental contact with battery fluid, clean with clear water immediately. If the battery fluid keeps in contact with the eyes, wash with clear water and must seek hospital assistance. Fluid from leaked battery may cause irritations or burns.

Maintenance

Cleaning

Hazard! Always pull out the battery pack before starting any cleaning work.

- Keep all safety devices, air vents and the motor housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible. Wipe the equipment with a clean cloth or blow it with compressed air at low pressure.
- We recommend that you clean the device immediately each time you have finished using it.
- Clean the equipment regularly with a moist cloth and some soft soap. Do not use cleaning agents or solvents; these could attack the plastic parts of the equipment. Ensure that no water can seep into the device. The ingress of water into an electric tool increases the risk of an electric shock.

Blade Replacement

When the moving blade no longer crosses the fixed blade throughout its length, or when the power pruner could no longer have a clean cut after grinding, blade replacement is recommended to performed by authorized service centers.

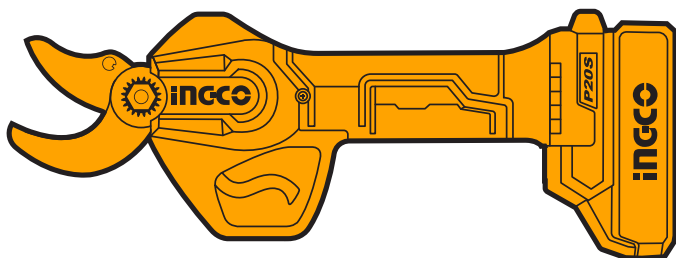
1. For safety, before replacing the blade, please ensure the pruning shear is power OFF and power cable disconnected from the battery.
2. Clean up the blade after replacing, connect to power cable to battery, power ON to test the blade, close up the blade to complete the whole procedure.

Troubleshooting

Danger! Before troubleshooting, switch off the equipment and remove the battery. The table below contains a list of fault symptoms and explains what you can do to remedy the problem if your equipment fails to work properly. If you fail to localize and solve the problem after working through the list, please contact your nearest service workshop.

Fault	Possible cause	Remedy
The equipment does not work	-Set the ON-OFF main switch to the OFF position - Battery empty - Battery is not correctly inserted	- Set the ON-OFF main switch to ON - Charge battery - Remove battery and insert again
The equipment stops during cutting	- Battery empty - Battery capacity low	- Charge battery - Charge battery
The cutting blade becomes jammed in a thick branch	- Battery capacity low - Wood too hard - Wood diameter too large	- Charge battery - Wood is unsuitable for cutting - Wood is unsuitable for cutting
The cut is not smooth	- Cutting blade is blunt or worn	- Replace cutting blade
